IT'S BEEN A WHILE SINCE OUR LAST ISSUE...

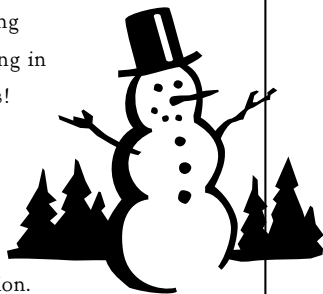
